A piece of land, the property of Sir Henry Bedingfield in the occupation of Mr. Oldman Carter, called The Fen Feolng was spoken of as suitable, and the persons wishing to hire were requested to put in writing their wishes & proposal to hire - and to put the same into the hands of the chairman with a view to his communicating with Sir Henry Bedingfield & Mr. Carter.
