of the Manor, respecting removal of Ob-
structions to the Drainage on the Com-
mon Land.

It was also desired by the
meeting unanimously to place on record
the sorrow felt by all at the death of
our Sovereign Lady the Queen, their
thankfulness to God for the great blessing

to the nation of his long reign, and their
loyalty to King Edward VII - whom
may God long preserve and bless!
