After Public Notices on Doors of places of Public worship a parish meeting was held in the School-room at 7-5 'Clock.

The overseen Mr Daintree and Mr S. Fails informed the meeting that the amount required as Contribution from the Union Board, would require that a rate be levied of $\frac{1}{8}$ in the pound.

The provisions of the School-land the New Education Act of 1902 was laid before the meeting by the Chairman who is the sole owner of the School premises - and the whole was discussed.

A resolution proposed by the Rector Rev^d G. G. Bird and seconded by Mr Daintree - overseen was unanimously carried.

That Mr Harmin is heartily thanked for his services to the Parish for the past 33 years, and is requested to continue to act as Correspondent and to transact any necessary business with a view to the transfer of the present School premises to the Norfolk County Council Committee of Education, on such terms as he and they may arrange.

To this Mr Harmin agreed for the present.
