April 1- After due notice a door of places of Worship - Parish meeting was held in the Sunday School room - as previously -

The Overseers accounts were produced and approved -

The present Overseers were thanked for past services and were unanimously re-elected - namely -

Mr. Stephen Fails

Mr. Samuel Freeman
as Overseers for the coming year -

The formal notice to the Board of Guardians was duly signed in the meeting by the presiding Chairman and by two Parochial Electors

Mr. G. Pettit as appointed, Parishes Constable - was approved -

Mr. Harwin resigned the Chairmanship - consequent on his advanced age and increased deafness -

Rev. J. G. Bird - the Rector of the Parish was elected as Chairman for the ensuing year -

The meeting was numerously attended. The Small Holdings Act - was discussed and Mr. Sherman stated that he had applied to the Local Government Board - on the matter -

Allotments - were discussed - and names of Applicants were given - totalling 15 acres -

Land belonging to Warrens Charity - Othorpe Farm in the occupation of Mr. Harwin was

Spoken of as suitable - and Mr. Harmin
expressed willingness to give it up - provided
the Trustees of the charity were willing to
let it for the purpose - if necessary as from
Oct 11. 1908 -

Nothing further being practicable
the meeting broke up - understanding that Mr.
Bird would take further action in the
matter -

May 6th

After due notices on doors of places of worship the Parish Meeting was held in the Sunday Schoolroom as previously

The Rector of the Parish (chairman), the Overseers, Mr. R. Harwin, and others were present

The Chairman read the letter of reply from the County Council, and from the Trustees of Herman's Charity, Oxborough, and he explained that it was now necessary to decide what land at Boughton was suitable for allotments, and to learn if any of such land can be acquired by agreement and to consider what further action was to be taken

It was proposed, seconded, and carried that the field, Common lot, the property of the Oxborough Trustees, field 10 acres, on the boundary of Boughton Parish and abutting on the Stoke Ferry Road, the property of Mr. R. Harwin, and big crofts, abutting on the Parish road to Boughton Fen, the property of Sir. H. Beddingfield, be suitable for the allotments

No other resolution was proposed at the meeting. A vote of thanks was given to Mr. Harwin for the use of his Schoolroom.
