It was reported at this Meeting that the Parish
was without the services of a gravedigger & that
in the case of death it might be a difficult matter to
find any person to dig graves. The Clerk
pointed out that the Meeting had no power to
appoint a permanent grave digger & that
the appointment rested with the Rector of the
Parish, ~~from whom was stated during the~~
~~meeting~~. After considerable discussion on
