

March 18. 1932 The Annual Parish Meeting was held in The School on Friday March 18th. Present. Rev. J. S. Beloe. Messrs S. Procter, H. Nelson, Mr. Milson, W. Clarke, Mr. Miller, J. Lambert, H. Hall & J. Hall & others. It was proposed by Rev. J. S. Beloe & seconded by Mr. Marks that Mr. J. Hall be appointed Chairman for the ensuing year.

A letter was read by the Chairman from Mr. Hynes re. Baughston Water Scheme. It was moved by Mr. Milson & seconded by Mr. H. Nelson that Mr. Hynes be written to - saying that a Parish Deputation will be pleased to meet Mr. Rigg (the Sanitary Inspector) for the R. F. C.

It was moved by Mr. H. Nelson & seconded by Rev. J. S. Beloe that the Chairman get two Stiles erected on the Right of Way or Foot-path from Cavenham Corner to the Church through the fields belonging to Mr. L. Hawkins Mr. Marks & J. Hall. coming out at the Gate close to the Church.

Rev. J. S. Beloe wished it to be recorded in the Parish Book that the Little Map recording the Gravel Pit (15 acres) in Mr. Marks Farm & the Chalk Pit (1 acre) in Mr. S. Procter's Common is at present in possession or lent to Donald L. Jackson Solicitor, Wodeck.
