The Annual Parish Meeting was held in the School on Monday April 5th due notice having been given Present, Mr R. G. Robinson. Mr. S. J. Proctor. Mr H Hall. Mr. E. Marks Rev. E. V. Salbot and Mr E. Savage.

Mr R. G. Robinson proposed and Mr S. J. Proctor seconded that Mr H Hall be chairman for the ensuing year.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Proposed by Mr H Hall and seconded by Mr S. J. Proctor that Mr E. Marks be elected a school manager in the place of Mr J. Hall. carried.

It was the unanimous wish of the meeting that a new stile be erected the 'Dublin' end of the footpath leading from Church Lane to Canham Corner. Also one repaired, the cost being met out of parish funds. The chairman was asked to get the work done.

Mr Robinson proposed and Mr S. J. Proctor seconded that the attention of the Downham Rural Council be called to the very bad state of both Crabbe and Fen Roads.

Also the need of widening the
Wretton Rd near Mr Hall's barn.

Proposed by Mr E Marks and
seconded by Mr Robinson
that the Downham Rural
Council be asked to erect
two houses in Boughton.

It was also proposed
and carried that the chairman
writes to the Rural Council and
asks what steps should be
taken to bring pressure to
bear on the East Anglian
Electric Supply Co. to extend
their supply from Stoke Ferry
to Boughton for the use of
the Parishioners

The Rev. E. V. Talbot proposed
a vote of sympathy be sent
to Mr J. Hall in consider-
ation of his long-continued
ill-health.
