The chairman read a letter from the District Council re offer of hand pump in case of fire due to the war. Mr Hall was asked to write to the council and accept the offer, and also state that a suitable place had been found for storage.

It was proposed by Mr A. Hall and seconded by Mr S. J. Proctor that Mr. R. G. Robinson be appointed chairman for the ensuing year.
