The Annual Parish meeting was held in the Schoolroom on Monday March 28th due notice having been given on the Church & Chapel notice boards.

Parishioners present being
Mr R. G. Robinson, Mr S. J. Procter,
Mr C. Price, Mr Tom Price, Mr E. Smith, Mr J. Bruce
Mr E. Price & Mr E. Marks.

Mr Procter proposed & Mr Robinson seconded
with general assentment that Mr Marks be
appointed Chairman for the ensuing year.

A letter received from the County Public
Health Office was read regarding the appointment
of a person to serve on the Housing Committee
which is being formed & it was proposed
by Mr Procter & seconded by Mr Robinson that
Mr E. Marks be approached with this object in
view.

It was decided to press the Council regarding the
very bad state of the road around the Village
pond & down the Gub road by the Church, it
being considered that further down the road a pipe
should be laid to take the water off the road.
It was also asked that the Chairman make
enquiries regarding the proposed water supply &
concern was felt regarding the future position of
the Parishioners in a long time.

Mr Bruce asked that the Telephone Manager be
approached with regard to the installation of a
light in the Public Phone Box.

Mr Robinson commented on the housing
situation regarding Broughton & said he noticed
that in adjoining Villages houses were being
put up in quantity, whereas in a period of

the last twenty years only two small Bungalows
have been built in Boughton.

Mr Proctor said that Boughton had been
allocated two new houses & work should soon
commence thereon. It was decided to pass for
more than two houses, the parishers present
thinking Boughton was getting a raw deal in this
respect. The Chairman was asked to deal with
the matter & see what could be done

left the village) be elected en bloc & that
Mr E. Marks's name be submitted to the Education
Office as the County Primary School manager.

It was also suggested that the Chairman of
Wereham Parish Council be approached with
regard to their proposing a manager from that
Parish to serve at Boughton, seeing that so many
children from the outskirts of Wereham Parish
attended Boughton School.

This concluded the business.

A Parish meeting was held in the Schoolroom on Friday June 17th due notice having been given on the Church's Chapel notice boards & at various places in the Parish.

Parishioners present being Mr C. Rice Mr Milson Mr Miller, Mr E. Rice, Mr S. Everett, Mrs P. Rice, Mr W. Rice, Mr H. Rice, Mr S. J. Proctor, Mr E. Smith, & Mr E. Smith.

The meeting was called to consider an offer made by the Church Commissioners for the Parish to purchase the Church room at a price of £150. After long discussion in which the Chairman pointed out that the amount of money available from the Parish funds amounted to £13-5-9d it was decided to refer the matter back to a further meeting, after enquiries had been made regarding the possibility of raising the money.

On a motion being put to the meeting as to if the Parish should purchase five persons agreed to purchase & none was against, but the five in favour would not take responsibility to raise the necessary money.

The proposed water supply was discussed & after Mr S. J. Proctor had enlightened the meeting as to business in this respect being done by the Devonshire Rural Dist Council it was decided to let the matter rest for the time being.

Mr Proctor also stated that the County Surveyors had examined the road around the pond & Crabb Lane & it was going to be repaired. This concluded the business & the Chairman called the meeting closed.
