The Annual Parish Meeting was held in the School Rooms on Thursday March 29th. at 7 pm. pursuant to notices having been posted.

The Chairman then told the meeting that he had had a letter from the Norfolk County Council, with reference to Public Rights of Way, saying that the objection put forward by Hall-Markes Hatchery ^{Stoke Ferry} in the case of Public Footpath in Bighton from the Church to Leadman Corner, had not been upheld, and so this would remain on the map, without modification, as a Public Footpath.

The Chairman then said that though we had received the right to keep this footpath it did not seem at all clear to him how it was going to be maintained. He would try to find an answer to this before the next meeting.
