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A general meeting was held on Monday Dec: 9th. 1963 in the School Rooms at 7 pm. Present were Mr. Cooper, Mr. C. L. L. and Mr. R. Proctor and the Chairman. As this had been the only meeting held during 1963 it was agreed that the Chairman should continue in office until the next annual Meeting in 1964. A discussion then took place on the Public Footpath from the Church to Leadham Corner. The chairman expressed the view that if the meeting wished he would make enquiries to find out if the whole subject could be forgotten and the path erased from the Ordnance map as a public footpath. The subject of the reeds in the pond was discussed again and Mr. Proctor said he would endeavour ^{to get} a weed killer as soon as ~~the~~ the young growth started. There being no further business to discuss the chairman declared the meeting closed.
