Election The chairman resigned and asked for nominations for the post.

Other Business

Mr Coulten raised the subject of the sale of the village school, in which he stated that he thought the village should attempt to acquire the building for a village hall. After a lengthy discussion the chairman ruled that, since the Parish Meeting of 17th October had clearly decided against acquiring the building, the subject was closed.

It was generally agreed to hold a village fete on Saturday 4th July and that the chairman, Mr F Savage and Mr F Reid would organise it.

It was also agreed that the village would provide petrol for the church lawnmower.

The chairman suggested that the Parish Meeting should honour Mr Trowd's contribution to the Parish as headmaster of the School for so long, by making a presentation at the village fete. It was agreed that paintings of the pond and school would be most suitable and the chairman agreed to find an artist to do the job. Mrs Shafte and Mrs C Proctor volunteered to hold a collection in aid of the presentation.

Mrs J Savage asked about the rules regarding smoke from bonfires. PC Parfitt stated that the Public Health Inspector should be informed.

It was also agreed to cut back the buckthorn by the pond which was a nuisance to grass cutting.

Mrs Payne announced that visitors to Boughton Wood were welcome on Sunday afternoon and that any contributions received would help the church and school funds.
