

A. Parish Meeting was held in the Chapel Vestry at 1930 hrs on Tuesday 17th January 1989 due notice having been posted.

The chairman welcomed new members and read the minutes of the previous meeting. These were duly approved by the meeting.

Business Arising

The chairman explained that he had contacted the County Surveyors department about the future of the Wretton road and that it was likely to stay closed. The chairman also stated that he had written to the Borough Planning Officer asking for someone from his department to attend the annual parish meeting. He also explained that he had contacted Dr Bolam about the traffic hazard on the road near his surgery, and that Dr Bolam was aware of the problem and was taking steps to

improve the situation.

Boughton Village Development Guideline

The meeting discussed at some length the Policy Guideline for the village. Mrs Payne suggested that the conservation officer be invited to attend the annual parish meeting in April and Mr Boulton suggested that the local Borough councillor also be invited to attend. The chairman agreed to invite both the conservation officer and Mrs Bowleson to the annual parish meeting. Mr Wilkinson pointed out that the planning department was not consistent in the implementation of the policy guideline by allowing more houses to be built than allowed for in the guideline. Mr & Mrs Armsby pointed out that access roads to the village were too narrow to cope with present traffic and that with increasing numbers of dwellings the problem would get worse.

It was proposed by Dr Bolam and seconded by Mr Wilkinson that the chairman write to the Borough Planning Officer to point out to him that he is not implementing his own guideline by allowing more dwellings than suggested in the policy statement and allowing overintensive development. The meeting supported the proposal.

Mr Beeson suggested that it would be more reasonable to extend the guideline than to suffer from overintensive development.

Other Business.

Mr Boulton suggested that since only one village sign existed (at Bavenham corner) he would check on the availability of another to erect on the Stoke road.

Mr Davis stated that the signpost at the Ten bridge was damaged. The chairman agreed to write to the divisional surveyor to try to get it repaired.

Mr Boulton agreed to refurbish the village sign by the pond and also to see if it is possible to cast one from alloy in order to reduce maintenance.

Mrs J Savage stated that soil outside the school was obstructing the road. The chairman agreed to speak to the owner of the school about the problem.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting closed at 20.45 hrs.
