Business Arising

Village Fete was held on Saturday 3rd July 1993. The sum of £590-52 was raised of which £365-92 was donated to the church funds and £225 to the Village funds (eg 590 + 141 (pncept) = 730 ÷ 2 = 365 to church)

The chairman stated that he had written to Mr Bob Smith asking him to pay peppercorn rent for the small piece

of land which he had fenced off and claimed on the ten. No reply had been received, it was agreed that the subject should not be pursued any further since the Parish could not afford to take legal action.

Mr A Beeson explained that the task of maintaining posts and railings around the pond was in hand and would be completed when the necessary materials became available. The chairman explained that according to the divisional surveyor the pond belongs to the parish and is therefore a Parish responsibility for maintenance of erosion etc.
