The Chairman explained that the blacksmith Tom Bonnett had carried out the necessary

repairs and maintenance on the slide, swing and rocking horse. The total cost was £251.69p. The unsafe well at the eastern edge of the pond had been filled in and a path has been made between the pond and the road making a safe walkway. This work was carried out by Mr Nigel Morton and helpers.
