 OFFICER, KL & W NORFOLK – RURAL SEWERAGE
 Mr Wilson explained there was a duty on AWA to provide public sewerage
 to villagers if problems exist. In general most parishioners had problems

with sewage disposal. As a result ASB would prepare a common form for all households to complete, after distribution and then collected and sent to Mr Wilson.

In the event of a public sewage system being viable it could take 5 years to complete. In the mean time conserve water.
